All others will need to complete the **PINK RESERVATION FORM** with the **DATE**, **YEAR** and **EXPECTED CAPACITY**. **TIME** for **SET UP** and **CLEAN UP**, with the **ACTUAL TIME OF THE EVENT**.

Please remember, even if you have had your events in the same room for many years doesn't mean that it will be available. There are more clubs/events/activities then ever before and trying to reserve rooms is getting very difficult. No reason some group with 20 people need to have CH2, the ANNEX or CH3 if there are smaller rooms available.

I hope you all can understand the predicament I have scheduling so many that want just one room all the time. It won't work anymore.

*Right now, for 2025-2026 season all rooms are practically full.
So, there might be times I will have to change your reserved room.
I am hoping I won't have to, but please understand if I do.*

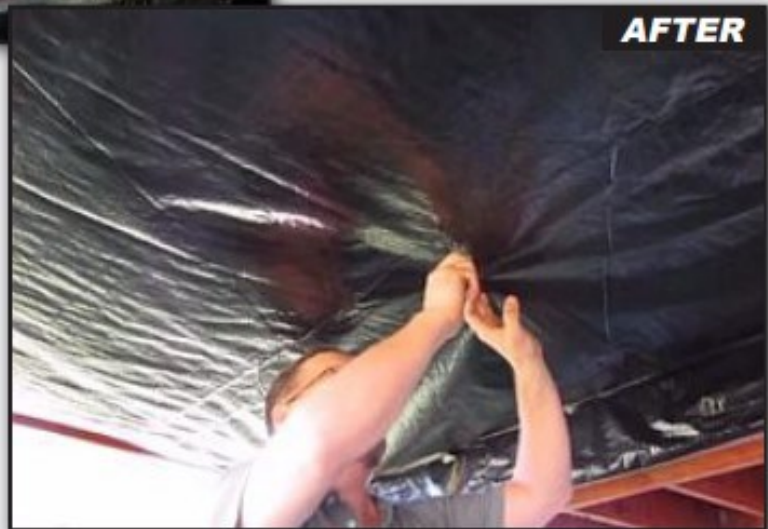

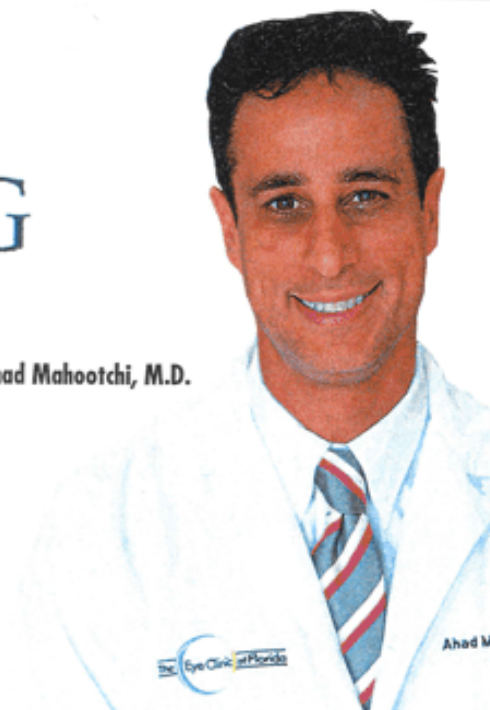

BETMAR GARDENS BULLETIN APRIL, 2025

With spring approaching, you will see some plants and flowers starting to bloom. The Milkweed is in full bloom already and blooms throughout the year. Milkweed is a vital plant for the monarch butterflies, serving as their sole food source as caterpillars and a nectar source for adults. Milkweed is the only plant that monarch caterpillars can eat, and monarchs lay their eggs exclusively on milkweed plants. You will also see the Amaryllis starting to bloom. Amaryllis are tropical plants with large, trumpet shaped flowers that can grow up to 10 inches in size, they also come in a variety of colors. Amaryllis blooms typically last 2 - 3 weeks. You will also see that the Azaleas are still in bloom.

We always ask the people refrain from feeding the ducks and other wildlife as it is prohibited. Feeding the ducks bread is very bad for them. Bread is a processed food that is high in carbohydrates and low in nutrients that ducks need. It causes several health problems for the ducks, including: malnutrition, angel wing and digestive problems. Uneaten bread can decompose in the water releasing harmful bacteria and contributing to water pollution. Ducks are omnivores, and their diet consists of a variety of foods, including aquatic plants, insects, & small fish.

The Betmar Garden's next month meeting is **Monday, April 7, 2025 at 9:00 am in the Blue room of the Apache Clubhouse**. We will have a speaker at this meeting, Mary Ellen Gotto. 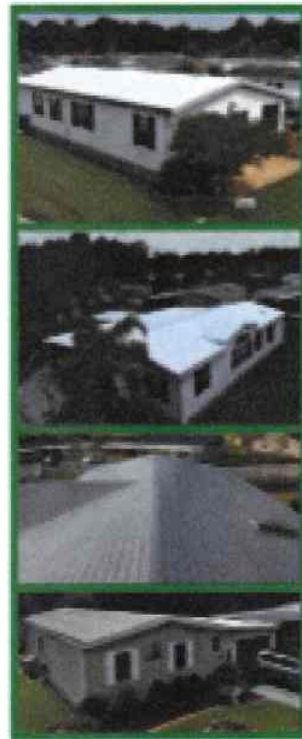
