14th Annual Healthorama Health Fair.

If you have never attended one of the health fairs, you should not miss this one. Lots of exhibitors displaying all kinds of health related, information and services available in our community. Free hearing exams, blood pressure checks, demonstrations and a door prize valued at \$25 awarded every 5-10 minutes (must be present to win and one door prize per person). Each exhibitor provides handouts and little giveaways at their tables. We average 40-45 health care exhibitors per fair. Elder care, home care services, assisted living, physical therapy, hospital providers and so on.

Too many to list them <u>all !!!</u>

LET'S DO THE HOPA!!! Isn't there a dance with that name? No, but close!

Seriously, <u>HOPA</u> is the acronym for *HOUSING FOR OLDER PERSON ACT* and it is a federal law in order for us to remain a 55 and older community. In that law, we must be able to document at least 80% of our community has at least one person age 55 living in the household. It is part of our Bylaws. <u>This includes renters!!!!</u>

- We no longer have to certify every two years so if you have registered with the office or attended one of the Mass HOPA sign ins and provided a driver's license showing your age, you do not have to register with the office again for HOPA.
- If you have never registered with the office, please do so ASAP so we can update records.
- If you are <u>not sure</u>, please check with the office.
- We have a diligent HOPA group working with the office to update and maintain accurate records; but they need NEW RESIDENTS & RENTERS to come to the office
- 5. Our biggest area of concern and difficult to capture is the renters.

So, if you are a landlord, it is <u>your responsibility</u> to have your renters check in with the office with their Drivers' license.

** If you are a renter and you have not checked in with the office, please do so and let your landlord know you have done this.

****This is soooo very important for us to maintain our HOPA status.



Seriously, <u>HOPA</u> is the acronym for *HOUSING FOR OLDER PERSON ACT* and it is a federal law in order for us to remain a 55 and older community. In that law, we must be able to document at least 80% of our community has at least one person age 55 living in the household. It is part of our Bylaws. <u>This includes renters!!!!</u>

- We no longer have to certify every two years so if you have registered with the
 office or attended one of the Mass HOPA sign ins and provided a driver's license
 showing your age, you do not have to register with the office again for HOPA.
- If you have never registered with the office, please do so ASAP so we can update records.
- If you are not sure, please check with the office.
- We have a diligent HOPA group working with the office to update and maintain accurate records; but they need NEW RESIDENTS & RENTERS to come to the office
- Our biggest area of concern and difficult to capture is the renters.

So, if you are a landlord, it is <u>your responsibility</u> to have your renters check in with the office with their Drivers' license.

** If you are a renter and you have not checked in with the office, please do so and let your landlord know you have done this.

****This is soooo very important for us to maintain our HOPA status.


