TENNIS/PICKLEBALL

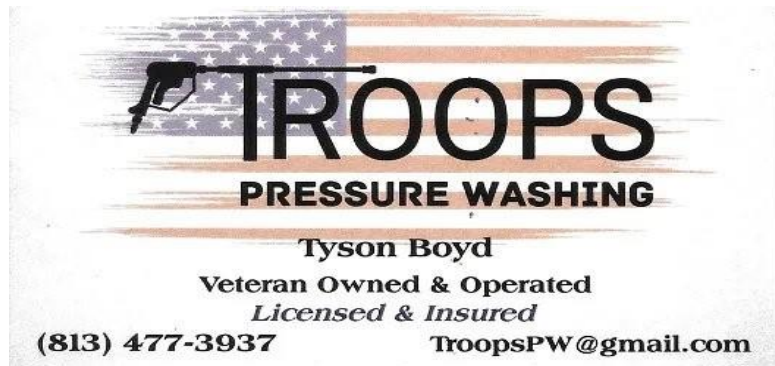
