Minutes for January 12, 2026

Board Members Present: Bob Engler, Deanna Wachsmuth, Jackie Giesler, Wayne Nareau, and Lori Kadwell

Absent: Diana Engler, Kim Elder, Kelly Reno

20 members were also present at the meeting.

Bob Engler, President, called the meeting to order at 9:35 am in CH2 Annex.

The Membership waived the reading of the minutes from the last meeting in December. The minutes were approved and will be posted on the Swim Club web page and Facebook.

President's Report:

Bob reviewed the status of the various on-going projects, including security software updates (including facial recognition), new chairs for the large pool, equipment repairs, and a potential problem with the small pool resurfacing project completed last year.

Treasurer's Report

Bob discussed the financial results. Expenses continue to track higher than anticipated but overall, we are in good shape. Current assets as of December 31, 2025, were \$327,132, a \$30,000 decrease due primarily to deposits for the new chairs and software. The unbudgeted expense for cleaners and increases in electricity costs were also contributing factors.

Fundraising Report

Picnic for the Pool is Saturday. We have sold 58 tickets and we are ready to go. You do not have to be a member of the Swim Club to buy a ticket. All are welcome.

Next picnic is scheduled for February 7th. After discussion, we decided to move it to the 14th as there were multiple conflicts on the 7th.

There was discussion about the feasibility of selling Ice Cream to supplement or replace the "Picnics." Some ideas included hosting Ice Cream socials at the pool or selling ice cream at Bandstand and Gazebo performances.

Many have suggested we go back to having the Picnics at the Pool. January and February are difficult due to the weather, but we may be able to have the March picnic at the pool again.

If the Owners/Acres Bylaws are approved later this month, Swim will have to update their Bylaws as well. Bob will appoint a committee to draft those for discussion at the February Membership meeting, with a vote scheduled for March.

Members and the Board discussed various issues, including 1) lap swimmers' request for additional lanes or temporary lines in the large pool, 2) lappers having issues with non-lappers using the large pool during the lap hours, 3) the small pool shower head not working properly, 4) the shower's instant hot water heater not consistently providing water of a reasonable temperature, 5) underwater bezels breaking in the large pool, 6) the location and appearance of the shed, 7) shelves in the shed and organizing the storage rooms, 8) how to dispose of the old lounge chairs once the new ones come in, and 9) enhanced enforcement of the requirement to always use your own fob when accessing the pools when the facial recognition software is activated. The new software is not yet functional and Jackie continues to keep track of memberships manually. They are working on it. Bob reiterated that the member allowing someone to enter without their own fob will be responsible for the infraction. Bob also agreed to look into the temporary lap line request and the shower concerns before the next meeting.

Of particular concern is the need for volunteers to run for Swim Club Board positions. The President and Treasurer are both stepping down and we need

replacements. The Board will be holding informational meetings for anyone interested to explain what is involved and how more members can get involved in various areas.

The next meeting will be our first-ever evening meeting. February 16th at 6:00pm in Clubhouse 3. It is important that as many members attend as possible as there will be important discussions on many topics in preparation for voting in March. Bob will present an updated budget which will require a membership vote. In addition, nominations from the floor for Board positions will be accepted at that meeting.

A member motioned to adjourn the meeting and there was a second. The motion passed unanimously and the meeting was adjourned.
