Roger Gravengood brought up a complaint he received from members about 5 people playing together. There is a rule that we play 4 as a group. Discussion was held. Some stated that they are told they should play 5 instead of 3 and 2 because it is faster. Carol LaFleche made a motion to keep the rule as 4. It was seconded and passed the vote to keep it at 4.

Bill Robertson gave an update on the courses. Duke was removing the temporary bridge today and the pallets will be removed soon. All linemen will be out by the 18^{th} or 19^{th} . Stump grinding needs to be done on blue and gold. Hoping to get groundwork started by 3/15. New greens will not be started until April or May. Have to wait until the green can be cut in the Carolinas. Wall on #5 white is going to be replaced but wont be done until another course opens. Will take 7 - 10 days. Some cart paths need work. Drainage on blue is being addressed by the county and Florida Water Management. They are working together on a solution. There is still some tree trimming to be done. It is possible they will open gold temporarily after fairways are aerated and fertilized and sprayed for weeds. Root cutting will

be done on blue and gold. Cost is \$2000 for the day. They will try to include 2 greens on white if they have time.

Peter addressed the rumor of membership fees being increased. Asked Carol to post a notice on the website stating there is no increase scheduled at this time.
